Bigstone Cree Nation is seeking Elder's/Trappers as needed, the incumbents will report to the Consultation Manager. The Elder/Trapper will be responsible for performing field activities and office activities related to the collection, assessment, and reporting of environmental, cultural and traditional data. As much of the assignment will involve travel and work in remote areas, the successful candidate must be able to act independently, exercise sound judgment and is physically fit.

DUTIES/RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Research all environmental and Wildlife acts, codes, regulations, and best practices within Reserve lands, T.L.E., and Traditional Territory,
- Collect and maintain environmental baseline data within all reserve lands and traditional territory (as required),
- Conduct environmental field site assessments, and complete site assessment forms,
- Participate in meetings, and map sessions,
- Maintain and operate all equipment in safe manner,
- Participate in all required training sessions (courses, workshops, etc.),
- Perform other duties as assigned by manager.
- Proper safety gear for weather and operating equipment (ATV, Skidoo)

QUALIFICATIONS/SKILLS:

- Effective time management, decision making, and planning and organizing skills,
- Detail-oriented and able to follow and maintain accurate, detailed documentation and policies,
- Ability to effectively communicate both in oral and written form;
- Extensive knowledge and appreciation for Bigstone Cree Nation people, culture, language, history, values, traditions, and extended family relationships;
- Maintain high degree of confidentiality;
- Valid Alberta Driver's Operator license, and reliable transportation;
- Ability to understand and speak Cree is an asset;
- Must be bondable – a criminal record check is required;
